- A professional resume outlining work experience and should highlight any volunteer involvement and/or academic achievement.
- Completed Essay details on page 2 (approx. 300 to 500 words).

## Judging

Applications will be judged based on the following criteria:

<b>Completed Application</b> All your documents are submitted together complete with a covering letter	<i>10 points</i>
<b>Professional Resume</b> Shows some level of leadership through extra-curricular activities in the areas of sports, academics, volunteerism etc.	<i>20 points</i>
<b>Essay</b> Judges will be looking for an essay that is clear and concise, demonstrates knowledge of issues and makes reference to external material such as industry websites and publications. The essay should demonstrate independent thought and creativity by providing suggestions and opinions.	<i>20 points</i>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<i>50 points</i>
